The improvised underpinning of this show was ignited in me about 5 years ago when club member Rufus led us in an improvised sketch during a club “Green Room” social evening. About three years ago, I had the opportunity to join an Improv Group and was trained in basic improvisation skills. Later, I proposed that we get an Improv trainer to come to Headley and teach us, which happened in November 2023. Since then, there have been bits and pieces of improvisation woven into shows and occasional Improv sessions to keep our skills alive.

The opportunity came to put on a Murder Mystery and Archie Wilson kindly allowed us to use the framework he wrote, on which to develop our own show. What you see tonight has been created by using improvisation techniques to develop our characters, their backstories and motivations by putting them into a wide variety of situations that happened in their imagined lives.

We have had a joyful time creating and rehearsing this show, and every cast member has had input into every aspect of the show. We think that we have created a complex and rich set of characters who all have their reasons for murder, and a series of clues which will help you untangle the truth from the false leads. We hope that you enjoy this mystery as much as we enjoyed creating it.
